Wayne State University provides statistical expertise to identify early signs of Alzheimer's in Latinos

DETROIT, Oct. 19, 2015: Wassim Tarraf, assistant professor at WSU's Institute of Gerontology, is a co-investigator and lead statistician on a \$5.67 million five-year study

The lead principal investigator of this National Institute on Aging grant is *Hector González*, a colleague of Tarraf's at WSU and now an associate professor at *Michigan State University*. The project will recruit 6,600 Latinos, age 52 and up, from 16,000 participants in the Hispanic Community Health Study / Study of Latinos begun in 2011.
