COURSE OBJECTIVES:

By the end of the term, the student will:

- Recognize and be familiar with *cutting edge* theories of aging that constitute some of the major new insights of critical gerontology, e.g. political and moral economy, humanities and aging, adult development and successful aging, cultural perspectives and minority aging.
- Develop an integrative way of understanding and solving problems through readings and by engaging in reflective, critical discussions with other students and faculty.
- Assess his or her professional growth in knowledge, skills, and attitudes towards the process of aging.
- Develop expertise in performing online course technologies, e.g. discussion boards, virtual group discussions, file transfers, internet maneuvering.
